CASTING A VOTE: To vote for the candidate of your choice, darken the response area (●) to the LEFT of the candidate's name. If you make a mistake, return your ballot to the Election Official and obtain another. Do not attempt to erase any marks made in error.

WRITE-IN INSTRUCTIONS: To vote for a write-in candidate, you must make a voting mark on or in the oval to the left of the name you have written in or your vote will not be counted. A write-in vote will NOT be counted unless the vote is for a DECLARED write-in candidate.

STRAIGHT PARTY INSTRUCTIONS: To vote a straight party ticket for all candidates of a political party on this ballot, except for candidates described below, make a voting mark on or in this oval and do not make any other marks on this ballot.

***To vote for any candidate for an at-large office (county council, city common council, town council, or township board if those offices appear on this ballot), you must make another voting mark for each candidate you wish to vote for. Your straight party vote will not count as a vote for any candidate for that office.**

***If you wish to vote for a candidate seeking a nonpartisan office or on a public question or judicial retention question, you must make another voting mark on the appropriate place on this ballot.**




SPLIT-TICKET VOTING: You may vote a Split Party Ticket by marking ONE of the party choices and then voting for individual candidates of your choice in any other party OR you may vote for individual candidates for your choice in each office.

SCHOOL BOARD/JUDICIAL RETENTIONS: If you wish to vote in a school board race or judicial retention question, you must make separate voting marks at the appropriate places as instructed on the ballot. Marking a political party device will not record votes for these races.

STRAIGHT PARTY TICKET SELECTION

You may vote a Straight Party Ballot for the party of your choice by selecting the party below.
OR
You may Split your ticket by selecting the party of your choice below and voting for individual candidates in any other party.

You are not required to vote a straight party ticket. If you do not wish to vote a straight party ticket, do not make a mark in this section, and proceed to voting the ballot by office.
